## APPLICATION PROCESS

### Application

Complete the application for admission. [point.edu/apply](http://point.edu/apply)

### Official Transcript

Send an official high school transcript, or it's equivalent, to Point University. Since you are still in high school, submit a transcript with your grades and credits thus far. Point must have an official high school transcript reflecting all completed coursework prior to enrollment. Point will also need any transcripts from any previously attended university, dual credit enrollment program, post-secondary school or credit-by-examination testing (e.g. CLEP or AP)

### Dual Credit Enrollment Form

Send this form to Point once completed and signed by you, a parent or guardian and your high school guidance counselor.

### TUITION

\$250 per credit hour (This is a significantly reduced rate from standard tuition rate. We strive to make online education affordable for everyone.)
