| January | Spring term classes begin. Charge books in bookstore until the second week of class. Financial aid is disbursed to eligible students beginning on the 14 th day of classes. Appeal deadline for financial aid probation. |
| February | Students begin to receive financial aid stipends. |
| March | Spring graduation candidates complete exit counseling online at www.studentloans.gov . End of the 60% period for the Return of Title IV Aid. The Financial Aid Office will begin reviewing files for the upcoming fall term. Respond to all requests for information promptly to avoid delays in file processing. |
| April | Spring graduation candidates complete exit counseling online at www.studentloans.gov . Registration for summer term. Students with completed files may begin viewing their awards online for the upcoming fall semester. Students may continue to apply for aid by completing the FAFSA. Registration for fall semester. |
| May | Spring semester ends. Satisfactory Academic Progress is evaluated. Fall financial aid awards are available for viewing online. Summer classes begin. Students can submit HOPE GPA calculation request forms. Registration for fall semester. Financial aid for summer is disbursed to eligible students beginning on the 14 th day of classes. Fall Link sessions are held. |
| June | New Point University students must complete the online loan entrance counseling, available at www.studentloans.gov , for fall processing for the upcoming year. End of the 60% period for the return of Title IV Aid for summer. All state aid will be packaged for fall. Fall Link sessions are held. GA SAL applications open. Students will be notified if they qualify for the HOPE Scholarship. |
| July | Registration for fall semester. Fall Link sessions are held. Federal Direct Loan borrowers must complete Online Loan Entrance Counseling at www.studentloans.gov . |

- August** Fall orientation sessions are held.
Fall classes begin.
Financial aid is disbursed to eligible students on the 14th day of classes.
Charge books in bookstore until the second week of class.
- September** Direct Loans are disbursed to all new freshmen. (30-day hold on all first-time borrowers)
Students begin to receive their Financial Aid stipends.
- October** End of the 60% period for the return of Title IV aid.
Fall graduation candidates complete exit counseling online at www.studentloans.gov.
Registration for spring semester.

- November** Fall graduation candidates complete exit counseling online at www.studentloans.gov
