Student Engagement Director

The Student Engagement Director is a full time position which reports to the Associate Dean of Students and is primarily responsible to **Engage** students in co-curricular opportunities to ultimately, **Impact** their lives in a positive way and **Empower** them to transform themselves and their world. This position will plan events and programs which strengthen the student culture and organizational traditions of Point University, as well as promote students' academic, emotional, physical, cultural, social and spiritual health.

Responsibilities and Primary Activities

- Plan, promote, execute and evaluate campus-wide activities and events which increase student engagement and wellbeing.
- Serve as the staff sponsor for the Campus Activities Board (CAB), providing ongoing training and development to these student leaders.
- Provide programming excellence in the area of cultural diversity, teaching respect, inclusion and celebration.
- Supervise two student apprentices (Student and Diversity Engagement).
- Coordinates 3-4 intramural sport offerings per semester.
- Supervises hiring of intramural referee staff, oversees their scheduling, and approves timecards
- Overall supervision of the intramural program: scheduling, tracking seeding, attending and supervising games, and overseeing distribution and collection of intramural supplies.
- Assist the Associate Dean with planning Impact Day, the all-campus community service day.
