

## Graduate Assistant for Mentoring

Point University is a private liberal arts institution that educates our students within a Christian worldview so they are equipped to take their faith into the marketplace and all of life while achieving their professional goals. We are training the next generation of Christian leaders to take the cross to more job sites, churches, industries, and nations than ever before.

The Graduate Assistant for mentoring is a part-time position. Salary includes room/board and graduate tuition for one of the university's graduate programs. The position is primarily responsible for supporting the Associate Dean of Students with the expansion and development of the mentoring programs for men and women within the Point community.

### Responsibilities and Primary Activities:

- Available to students to discuss areas of concern, providing initial guidance and making appropriate referrals to community resources.
- Challenges students to develop healthy relationships with peers.
- Supports Student Life initiatives related to academic, spiritual, cultural, emotional health and wellbeing.
- Serves as a teaching assistant for a section of *Monday Matters*, a resiliency and success class for freshman football players (fall semester), and academically struggling students (spring semester).
- Facilitates or co-facilitates a mentoring-specific *Adventure Group* (weekly mentoring/Bible study small group) for students.
- Support the Associate Dean in building out the men's mentoring/life coaching program, which provides personalized guidance to male students in the discipline process, or who are experiencing transition difficulties and/or personal crisis.
- Contributes to the Professional On-Call rotation which covers evening, weekend and holiday availability for residential students.

### Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree and a desire to pursue a career path in Residence Life, Student Life or other areas of campus ministry
- 1 to 2 years Resident Assistant (RA) or CLM experience, or other applicable Residence Life/Student Life experience.
- Excellent communication, and relational skills
- Proficiency in MSOffice

### Preferred Qualifications

- Experience supervising others and leading teams preferred
- Experienced with collegiate athletes, minorities and first-generation college students
