

Dual Enrollment Coordinator

The Dual Enrollment Coordinator will report to the Director of Dual Enrollment Programs and have responsibilities with dual credit partnership schools in the greater Atlanta area. Some travel may be required.

Primary responsibilities include building and maintaining positive relationships with dual enrollment partner high schools, assisting in the assessment of the dual enrollment program; assisting with creating course schedules, working with faculty on the delivery of course outcomes, some classroom instructor observations, and teaching responsibilities as assigned by the Director of Dual Credit Enrollment Programs.

Requirements:

- Masters degree with 18 graduate semester hours in a subject taught in the DCE program
- Effective teaching ability/excellent communication skills
- Basic computer literacy
- Prior teaching experience at collegiate level preferred
- Some travel required
- Willingness to be a professional role model and mentor
- Commitment to undergraduate education, professional growth, service and scholarship in a distinctively Christian setting, including agreement with the University's mission and goals, values, and doctrinal statement
