

Two Steps Must Be Completed Before Returning to Campus for Move-In or First Day of Class on Campus

FIRST:

The Point Returns to Campus document attached to this email provides all of the information that you need to know about the preparations Point University is taking and requiring you to follow to provide a safe return to campus for students, faculty and staff. All information in the PDF as well as detailed regulations for following our Point Care guidelines is documented on this website: www.point.edu/point-care. The packet "Point Returns to Campus" references an acknowledgement that must be completed via the DocuSign process before returning to campus. Staff will be checking to make sure that it is signed before you return.

SECOND:

Before arriving to campus, you must complete **one** of the following requirements:

1. You may choose to be tested for COVID-19 and show proof of the negative test result upon arrival to campus. After the test is completed, we ask that you quarantine and continue to self-monitor until you return to campus.
 - a. If you are moving on campus, then you must show proof to your CLM (Campus Life Minister) in residential housing.
 - b. If you are a commuter and an athlete, then you must show proof to the Head Athletic Trainer, Adam Daum, before your first practice.
 - c. If you are a commuter and a non-athlete, then you must show proof to the Student Life Office.

OR

2. You must take the [Daily Screening Questionnaire](#) on Survey Monkey every day as a self-assessment regardless of whether or not you are experiencing any symptoms. We are asking that you start tracking the information at least 10 days before arrival to campus to get in the habit of completing the daily health screen while on campus each day. However, the last three to five days before arriving on campus are extremely important to complete using the survey tool.

Example: If you are scheduled to move on campus on August 10th, you would need to begin completing the survey on August 1.

If you test positive during this monitoring period or experience two or more symptoms on the daily health questionnaire, you should follow the CDC guidelines and contact student life to coordinate returning to campus.
