



Full-Time Professor, College of Biblical Studies & Ministry (open rank) – West Point, GA

Point University is a private liberal arts institution that educates our students within a Christian worldview so they are equipped to take their faith into the marketplace and all of life while achieving their professional goals. We are training the next generation of Christian leaders to take the cross to more job sites, churches, industries, and nations than ever before.

Point University's College of Bible and Ministry invites applications for a full-time faculty post to begin Fall 2022 (open rank). Candidates must engage in service and mentorship outside of the classroom with a focus on student spiritual formation. Candidates are expected to model spiritual development by engagement in chapel and other spiritual formation activities and an active life in a local church.

Candidates whose emphasis is in Old Testament, biblical hermeneutics, languages, ministry, and/or spiritual formation are especially encouraged to apply. Applicants must demonstrate excellence in undergraduate teaching, and while Point is primarily a teaching university, successful candidates should also show promise of scholarly contribution and engagement in the field.

The successful candidate will teach 8 courses over the course of two semesters (4-4) in the University's required Bible minor as well as major classes in the college of Bible and ministry. Candidates will thus be teaching a combination of biblical major and non-major students. Candidates are expected to teach both on-ground and online courses. They must participate in advisement and mentorship of students, as well as appropriate department, college, or professional service. Candidates who are strongly interested in biblical application and ministry are preferred.

REQUIREMENTS:

- **Graduate degree in biblical studies, ministry, or cognate field required; terminal degree preferred.**
- College teaching experience.
- Experience in online course development.
- Effective teaching ability with excellent communication skills.
- Commitment to undergraduate education, professional growth, service, and scholarship in a distinctively Christian setting, including agreement with the University's mission and goals, values, and doctrinal statement.
- Strong commitment to mentor students in the name of Jesus.
