Abilities and Skills

- Able to teach and relate to children very well
- Develop adults and students to assume leadership roles within the children's ministry
- Relate to others, including adult leaders, children, and parents as well as other ministers and elders in the congregation
- Provide objective solutions to concerns and inquiries

What are the responsibilities/duties?

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Minister to LCC children, including those who do not regularly attend activities, by developing personal relationships with children and their parents or guardians
- Work with existing volunteers while recruiting and training new volunteers
- Responsible of overseeing the implementation of LCC Child Protection Policy to include background screening and training for leaders working with children, creating a welcoming and safe classroom environment
- When possible, network with other youth workers in the community and plan, or attend, area events with other ministries
- Oversee curriculum selection and implementation for Sunday school, Children's church, and Wednesday evening classes for children
- Organize and oversee the recruiting of volunteers for children's activities, e.g., VBS
- Create and lead an atmosphere that supports summer church camp, leading a week of summer camp for elementary aged children when/if possible
- Lead baby dedications during worship services as needed
- Oversee and implement follow-up process for visitors
- Attend weekly staff meeting if possible
- Help manage the children's ministry budget
- Attend church functions and be a cheerleader and champion for the children's ministry
