#### Who We Are

Founded in 1937 as Atlanta Christian College, Point University originally devoted its attention to the education of ministers, missionaries and other church-related workers. In 1965, the college became an accredited member of the American Association of Bible Colleges (AABC). In 1990, in conjunction with a broadening of

the curriculum, the college was accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) to award associate and baccalaureate degrees. The University's graduate programs were approved by SACSCOC in 2016.


