The committee will review all applications and distribute funds above and beyond the previous distributions made this semester. We are required to disseminate all funds, and the updated regulations stress that we must identify those with a particular need.

Students should carefully read the following information before applying:

- Students must complete the application and indicate the specific need(s) for which they are applying to receive.
- Students must be enrolled at the time of the application and grant disbursement.
- Funds will be disbursed through Point's BankMobile disbursement system or, with the student's permission, applied directly to their account.
- The application period is from on Mar 30 Apr 6 at midnight.

This emergency financial assistance is for students encountering unfortunate circumstances due to COVID-19 that could disrupt them from continuing their education at Point. Circumstances that may lead a student to apply for these funds can vary. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision by April 20.
