Checklist for Traditional International Admission

International: A non-immigrant seeking an F-1(student) visa to enter the U.S. for the purpose of attending Point University or a current holder of an F-1 visa seeking to transfer to Point University.

Please keep this sheet for your reference. Applications will not be considered complete until ALL items have been received.

Application Form

Complete and return the application for admission online or in printed form. Submit \$25 nonrefundable application fee, payable by check or credit card.

Proof of English Proficiency

If English is not your first language, submit official scores from **TOEFL** with an **80** on the **iBT** (minimum 20 in each section), or **550** on paper-based exam, or **213** on computer-based exam.

If English is your first language, provide an official **SAT-I verbal score of 430** or higher or a transcript from an accredited college in the U.S., showing completion of the equivalent of ENG 101 & 102, with a C or above.

Official Transcripts

Submit a final transcript from all high schools and/or colleges attended.

If transcripts are from institutions outside of the U.S., you are required to submit a course-by-course credential translation and evaluation corresponding to credits and grades used within the U.S. Credential translation and evaluation **must** be ordered through **World Education Service** (<u>www.wes.org</u>) or **Josef Silny, Inc.** (<u>www.jsilny.com</u>).

_ Certificate of Finances

This is a required document to be returned with **original signatures**. See itemized explanation on web site.

__ Sponsor's Affidavit of Financial Support

If you have a financial sponsor other than your parent, fill out this form and return it notarized.

____ Spiritual Reference Form

This form needs to be filled out by someone in a position of spiritual leadership who is not related to you.

_ Housing, Medical History and Immunization Records

These forms must be complete with appropriate signatures.

____First Time International: Copy of passport cover, front page and any current U.S. Visa. **Once accepted**, issued an I-20, and granted entrance to the U.S., submit copy of stamped I-20, I-94, I-797C Notice of Action (re: I-901 SEVIS fee).

Transfer International: Copy of passport cover and front page, any current U.S. Visa, I-94, I-797C Notice of Action (re: I-901 SEVIS fee), and I-20.

A \$200 enrollment deposit should be submitted once you have received acceptance to attend Point University. The enrollment deposit is applied to your student account at registration, and is nonrefundable after May 1 for the fall semester and November 1 for the spring semester.
