

Student Worker - Science Laboratory Assistants

Usual Duties:

- Responsible for maintenance of all science laboratory equipment to include cleaning, sorting, and storing of glassware and lab equipment
- general maintenance of work areas (organization of counters and sink areas) and cleanliness of the laboratory classrooms
- provide assistance to course instructors as needed (may include grading of lab assignments)

Skills:

- organized, dependable, attentive to detail
- basic knowledge of laboratory safety procedures
- ability to maintain glassware with minimal breakage
- understand and follow basic instructions (verbal or written)
- **knowledge of course content (if grading of assignments is required)*

Physical Requirements:

- Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate and maintain laboratory equipment
- standing for long periods of time

***Academic:**

Preferably, student must have taken a science laboratory course and passed with an A or B.

(Must have taken that specific lab course – and passed with A or B – if grading assignments.)

Schedule:

Laboratory classes are held at various times on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays. Ideally, the student lab worker will be available before and/or after lab classes for set-up and/or clean-up. Time scheduled for grading assignments will vary, where applicable.
