The primary responsibility involves teaching CISM 330 using Canvas, Cengage MindTap, and GitHub. The candidate should demonstrate UI/UX development using HTML5, CSS, and JavaScript.

Course Title: CISM 330 - Foundations of Web Design

Course Description: Students will explore the core languages that power the structure and style of websites: HTML5 and CSS. Students will acquire a solid understanding of HTML5 and CSS and gain hands-on experience through interactive activities. Students will be equipped with the skills to build and style websites and webpages.
