communication pieces and creating and implementing the strategies needed to develop this essential part of the pipeline. If you love writing, connecting with people, and developing an organizational system, then this is the role for you!

Responsibilities

- Interview current missionary teams about their needs and projects and strategize how to present these opportunities to the greater Pioneers community
- Create resources and communication pieces that will equip current missionary teams to share on the database for missionary candidates who are considering teams to join
- Connect with Pioneers' other mobilization gateways and train members to effectively use our database as a knowledge management platform and as a mobilization tool
- Assist the Mobilization Team with various summer events that exist to coach, equip and mobilize the next generation of missionaries
- Complete administrative tasks assigned by the Director of Field Mobilization
