- Engage online students in course content, promote critical thinking, and foster a respectful learning environment.
- Evaluate student performance through assignments, quizzes, exams, and participation, providing timely and constructive feedback.
- Maintain regular office hours for student consultations
- Ensure adherence to university policies and procedures, as well as social work ethical standards and professional practice.
- Stay current with developments in social work education and practice, integrating new knowledge and techniques into the course experience.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree in Social Work (MSW) from an accredited program.
- A minimum of 5 years of professional practice experience in social work.

- Previous teaching experience at the college level is preferred but not required.
- A strong commitment to student-centered learning.
- Knowledge of social work theories, practices, policies, and current trends.
- Ability to integrate practical fieldwork experience into course instruction.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
